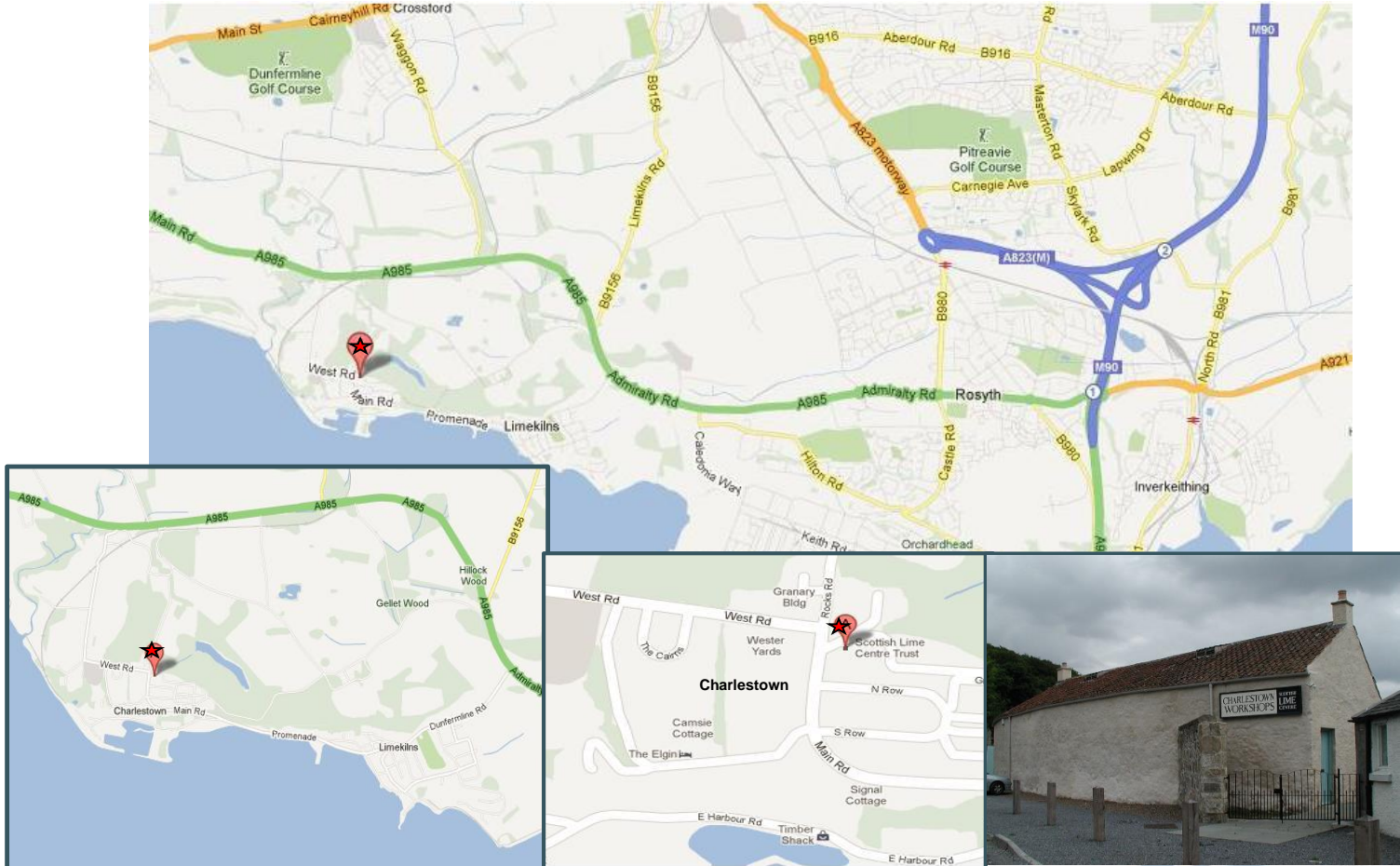




Helpful Information (by car) to Charlestown Workshops KY11 3EN



From South (M90): Proceed North over the Queensferry Crossing. Leave the M90 at Junction 1c and at the roundabout, take the first exit onto A985 towards Kincardine (heading West). Continue on the A985 through Rosyth crossing 3 roundabouts. About 1 mile beyond Rosyth turn left into Dunfermline Road at the sign for Limekilns and Charlestown. Drive through Limekilns and up the cobbled hill into Charlestown. Just past the village green, turn right immediately before The Sutlery (shop).

From North (M90): Heading South on the M90 take the Junction 1 A921/A985 exit toward Dalgety Bay/ Inverkeithing/ Kincardine. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Admiralty Rd/A985 heading West. Continue on the A985 through Rosyth crossing 3 roundabouts. About 1 mile beyond Rosyth turn left into Dunfermline Road at the sign for Limekilns and Charlestown. Drive through Limekilns and up the cobbled hill into Charlestown. Just past the village green, turn right immediately before The Sutlery (shop).

From West (Kincardine Bridge): Head northeast over the Kincardine Bridge. Head east along A985 for Rosyth and Forth Road Bridge. After approximately 12 miles, and half a mile after the village of Crombie, turn right at the sign for Charlestown and Limekilns. Follow the road for just under a mile to reach the village of Charlestown. Straight ahead is The Sutlery (shop) and we are located to the right of this building.

The Scottish Lime Centre Trust, reception and training centre, are based in Charlestown Workshops on the right of the shop (The Sutlery). Parking spaces can be found along the external wall of the workshops. We kindly request that visitors do not park in front of the local shop.
