



Course Title: Sash and Case Window Repair for Contractors

Duration: 1/2 Day

Course Description:

It is now widely recognised that sash and case windows should be retained in traditional buildings wherever possible and that even the most neglected windows can usually be refurbished by undertaking simple repairs. Join us for this half day course which will allow you to undertake repairs to traditional timber sash and case windows.

We will cover a short history of the development of windows before looking at the different components that make up a window and the issues to consider when approaching repairs.

- Ability to identify and address various problems that commonly occur with sash windows.
- Understanding of dismantling and reassembly of windows, replacing ropes, weights, panes, putty and traditional burnt sand mastic.
- Ability to undertake detailed window assessment to allow students to confidently perform a detailed window survey.
